

Visit the Wyckoff Teacher Resource Center (TRC) to access Artstor, an online digital library of over 1.5 million images in the areas of art, architecture, the humanities, and social sciences with a set of tools to view, present, and manage images for study and teaching.

ACCESS ARTSTOR IN YOUR CLASSROOM

From the TRC, K-12 classroom teachers and home school educators can create a login account to save high resolution images of art from institutions around the world—including over 2700 images from [SAM's Collection](#). Create image groups and presentations specifically for your classroom. Your individual login is good for 120 days—just come back into to the TRC to renew your account.

CREATING AN ACCOUNT, LOGGING IN AND SEARCHING

- Visit the TRC to register as a borrower and to sign the K-12 Artstor user agreement. Ask the TRC Librarian/Educator or a TRC Volunteer to help you create an account.
- Back in your classroom, go to <http://library.artstor.org> and click on the orange “Log in” in the upper right corner.
- Using the “Search” box for a keyword search of all the collections or click on “Advanced Search” to narrow your search by artist, title, date, geographic region or classification of art.
- Results will be listed by relevance, but you can also sort by title, creator or date. Double-click on an image to zoom in and out, print, save or view citation information. Add images to your own “Image Group” and save your images for next time from the individual image (using the icon on the far right) or the results page (highlight the image(s), click on “Organize” and “Save Selected Images”—your groups will be under “My Work Folder”). Note: When you double-click on an image, this opens a pop-up window. You may need to disable your pop-up blocker (for Internet Explorer, check the “Tools” menu).

IMAGE GROUPS AND PRESENTATIONS

- Access your Image Group from the main login page or from the icon on the search menu. Double-click on “My Work Folder” to see your image groups and double-click on the name of the group you want to open. Change the view to “View Large Thumbnails” and click on “View Full Record” under an image to add your own personal notes to each image.
- Export images to PowerPoint: From an Image Group, select “Export image group to PowerPoint” from the Tools menu or click on the icon. Account holders are able to download 2000 images in 120 days. This action will download images and their citations directly into a PowerPoint presentation.
- ARTstor’s offline presentation tool OIV (Offline Image Viewer): Download from the Tools menu of your account. This presentation software allows you to download images from an Image Group into a tool designed to work with Artstor images. View images side by side and zoom in and out with this rich resource. Please note that this software will download directly to your computer, so you may need to work with your school's IT department to install.
